3. Students taking this class for credit will also be given some outside reading assignments on a particular topic(s) and be required to write a three to five page paper on a particular topic.
4. To preserve as much class time as possible for instruction and questions and answers, the tests for this class will be take home exams. We will likely have three tests. I will give you the tests following class on a Monday night and the tests will be due to be turned in before class on the following Monday evening.
